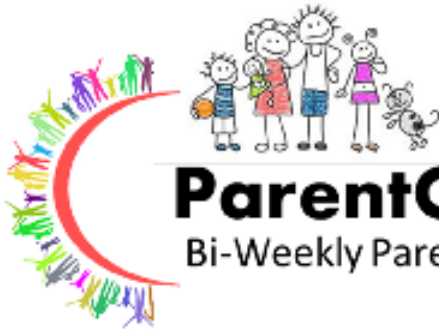


West Coast Recess
