General Behaviour Expecations

Some General School-wide Rules:

- Enter and exit the school using your classroom outside door. The bell rings at **8:55am** to indicate classroom doors will open. Dismissal is at **2:48 pm**.
- Please leave all expensive electronic devices at home unless you have permission from a teacher.
- Students are allowed to play at the back of the school but must stay out of the parking lot and inside the fence.
- Stay off chains and railing anywhere around the school.
- Be quiet when in the hallways and remember to **walk** on the right side.
- Students must have adult supervision in the gym, supply rooms or outside.
- All students should keep their hands and feet to themselves and always use appropriate positive language.
- Sticks, stones, sand, and woodchips should not be thrown at anyone or anything for any reason at any time on school property.
- Cell phones are discouraged at school. We have an office community phoe for emergencies. Students who bring cell phones to school are completely responsible for any damage, loss or theft. Additionally, cell phones are not to be used during school hours anywhere on school grounds or on school field trips.
 - If a student is caught using their cell phone at recess or lunch:
 - They'll be asked to put it away.
 - If they are caught a second time that day (or it becomes a pattern) then the phone will be taken for the rest of the day and returned to the student at the end of the day.
 - If the behaviour continues, parents will be contacted, and a plan will have to be put in place to manage cell phone access during the day.

Daycare, Burnaby Parks & Recreation and Other Outside Groups

- In general, and where applicable we expect any other groups using our facility to follow the same rules as outlined in this booklet. For example, students should not be running or shouting in the halls after school.
- In addition to the rules/guidelines outlined in this booklet we expect the following:
 - Only use the space that you are allotted. If you require the use of other areas please speak to the Principal (or designate) first.

- Leave areas the way you found them. For example, if you are using our gym equipment please return them in the same place (and manner) in which you found them. Same goes for our Staff Room.
- Please be respectful of other spaces and other groups that may be in the building at the same time. Students and/or adults under your supervision should not be entering other classrooms unless they have explicit permission to do so.

Soccer Rules

- **Language:** all players have to use appropriate language no swearing or put-downs allowed.
- Everyone is welcome to play as long as the teams are fair. We often separate based on grade.
- Players are not allowed to switch teams in the middle of a game unless both teams agree, and the teams are clearly unfair.
- No pushing, tripping, hitting allowed.
- If a player is reported to the Office as playing too rough, Mr. Gaster will speak to that player and give him/her an official warning. If it happens again, that player may be suspended from play for several days.

Follow entrance and exit directions	Stand quietly for the Coast Salish Anthem and O'Canada. Then sit quietly

Hallways	
Safety	Respect
Walk in a line, staying to the right	Be quiet in the hallways so you don't disturb others
Walk carefully around doors & corners	Go directly to where you are going, don't hang out in the hallways
Keep hands, feet & objects to self	Stop, look & listen when spoken to by adults



Washrooms	
Safety	Respect
Report any accidents or messes to the office	Leave walls free of graffiti
One person per stall only	Put paper towels in the bin (not in the toilet)
Wash your hands	Be quiet
Return to the classroom when finished	Respect the privacy of others
Use only the washrooms near your classroom	Flush the toilet
	Don't stand on the toilet seat or toilet paper dispenser

Students should only be in the staffroom with a supervisor	Leave the space neat and tidy
	Please knock on the door and wait for someone to open it



Office	
Safety	Respect
Sign in at the office when you are late and sign out when you leave early	Wait at the counter until an adult acknowledges you
Make sure you talk to an adult if you or a friend are hurt	Use a quiet voice when in front of the office
If you are waiting at the office for any reason, do not leave	Ask an adult for permission to use the phone



Hot Lunch Kitchen	
Safety	Respect
Please WALK when you have a tray in your hands	When it's your turn for lunch please line up quietly
Clear your trays into the green waste bins	Remember to say please and thank you
Wait until you get to your classroom to eat	Return your trays to the appropriate spot
	Please eat in the classroom and not in the hall (unless you are a helper in the hot lunch program)
